Responsibilities

Direct Service

- Provide ultrasound scans for any client who may benefit from this service in alignment with Caris' counseling model and the ethical standards of the field
- Implement all policies, procedures, and decisions set forth by the Board of Directors and Senior Leadership Team
- Act as an expert to answer ultrasound-related questions
- Consult with counselors and provide additional insight into client situations based on ultrasound appointments
- Maintain a positive working relationship with our Medical Director as needed

General Administrative Responsibilities

- Maintain accurate and up-to-date client documentation for records
- Complete all necessary client follow-up
- Participate in additional administrative projects as assigned by the Director of Client Services



Qualifications & Experience

Registered Nurse with a specialization in performing ultrasounds or a Bachelor's degree with R.D.M.S. certification. Experience in obstetrics and gynecology required. At least 2 years of experience providing ultrasound scans required.

Candidate must exhibit strong communication skills as well as exceptional care and compassion towards each Caris client. Candidate must have excellent administrative skills, sharp clinical skills/judgment and flexibility. Candidate must be able to calmly handle emergency situations such as ectopic pregnancy or other abnormal ultrasound findings.

Ability to teach small groups on topics related to pregnancy, prenatal care, labor and delivery, and newborn care preferred.
